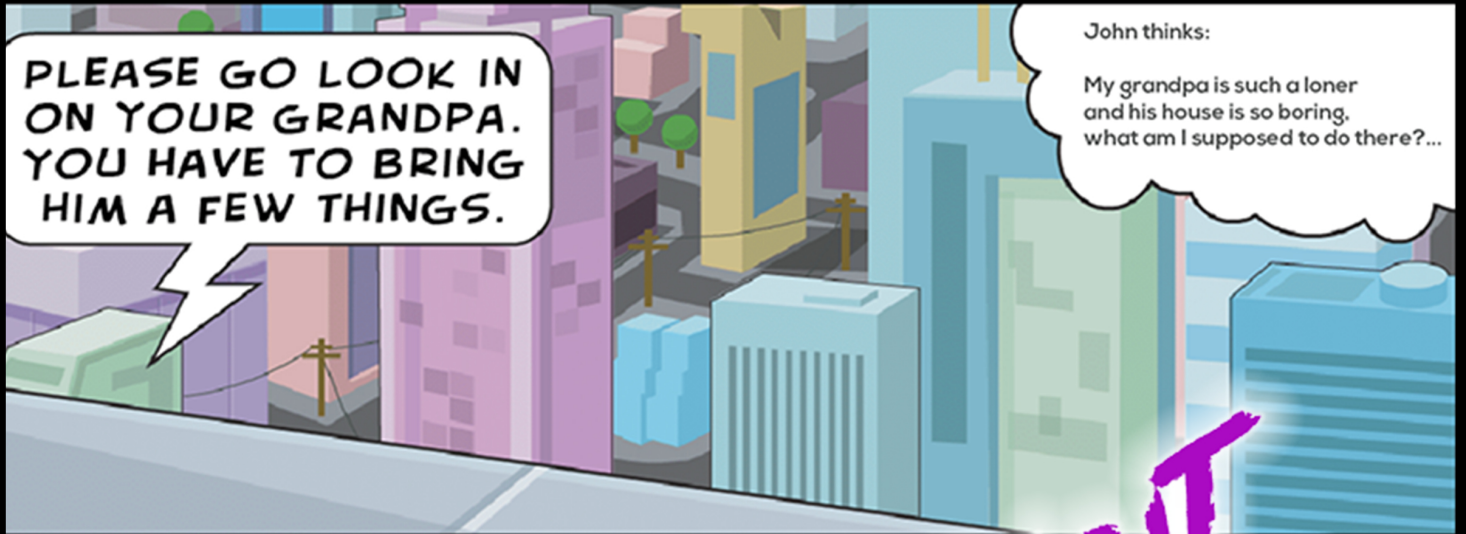

**JOHN COMES BACK WITH THE UNIFORM:**

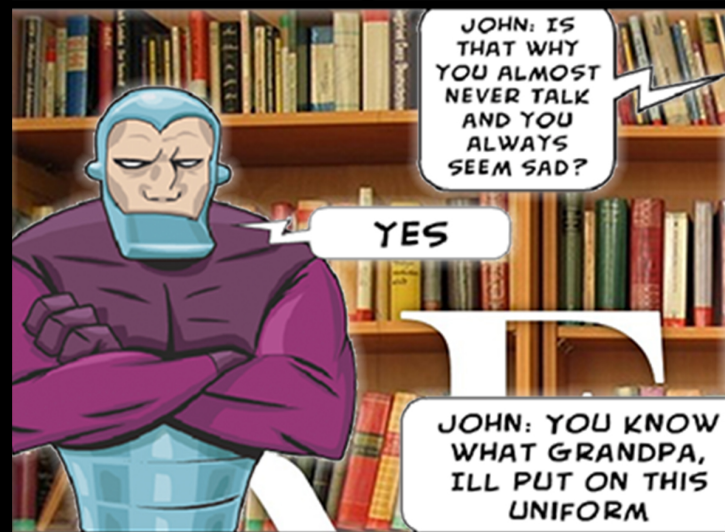
WHATS THAT, PA?

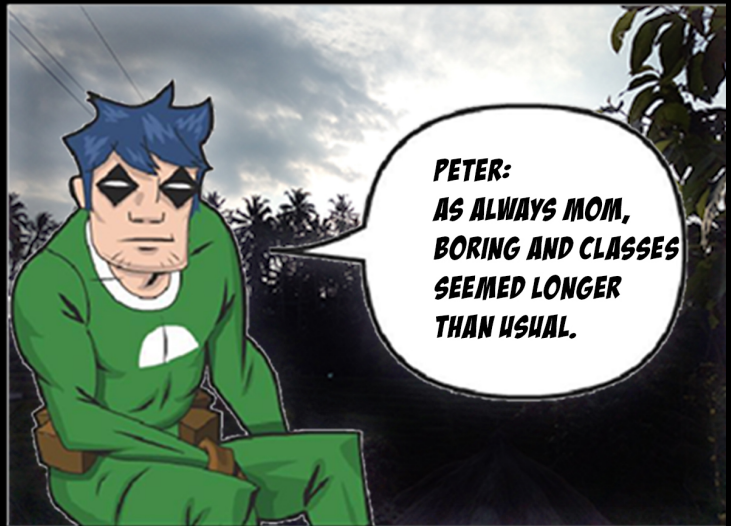

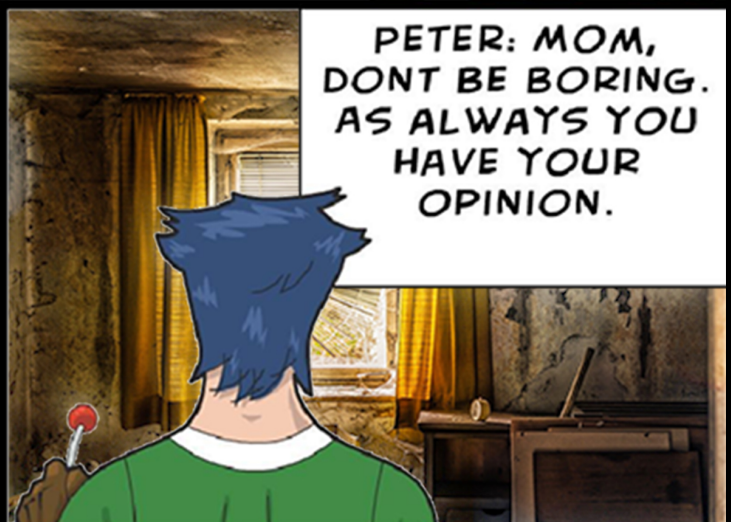

MOM: YOU'LL SEE, YOU'LL LIKE IT.


VISITORS WERE GREETED WITH A SMILE ON THE FACE OF THE GUIDE.
